The Therapeutic Riding Association of Ottawa-Carleton ("TROtt") is looking for a reliable team player with the necessary skills for the summer employment position of "Researcher on Horse-Assisted Recreation Programs for Neuro-Diverse Individuals".

Duties:

- Prepare a research document on evaluation relevant for horse-assisted recreation programs
 for neuro-diverse individuals, particularly for people on the autism spectrum. The document
 will propose an evaluation framework with tools. The tasks include gathering existing
 research on the topic, identifying evaluation tools that have been used by others to assess
 the impact of different horse-assisted recreation programs for various neuro-diverse people,
 summarizing the research, documenting sources using recognized citation standards.
- Speak with experts in the field to validate the proposed evaluation approach.
- Write up the findings, using technology to layout and edit the report into a format that would be readable by non-clinical practitioners in the field.
- Prepare a short powerpoint or other summary document of the highlights of the research.
- Present the highlights to other staff at the organization.
- Organize the evaluation tools in an electronic folder that our staff will access.
- Other duties as assigned, time permitting.

- Knowledge of neuro-diversity, inclusive recreation, recreation therapy, issues affecting people with disabilities, inclusion and/or accessibility
